The work was undertaken by professional bookbinders and gifted to us by church members. Next Sunday 22nd Feb, the 1st Sunday of Lent, we will dedicate the Lectern Bible for use in worship.

After meeting with Fiona Skellet and Judith Roebuck of the General Trustees we now have a much clearer picture of furnishings, furniture and Communion Ware that needs to be incorporated into the Sanctuary and Hall of Fellowship. I'll refer you to the Church Newsletter 'Our High Point' for more detail. We're going to begin by trialling the seating from Greenhills to see if it suits our needs and we'll be glad of your feedback. Overall, the process of merging furniture and furnishings may potentially transform the appearance of this sanctuary.

Trustees express thanks to all Elders who took time to complete and return the short survey issued to them in the last few weeks. In terms of providing Pastoral Care to the membership of the church, we are a long way off from being able to return to a system of Elders Districts. In the meantime, we will look toward establishing a Pastoral Team in order to provide some continuity of care and contact with church members.
